Augusta, GA - Mr. Andrew Milton Grimaud, 84, husband of Shirley Crawford Grimaud, died peacefully Saturday morning, August 24, 2013, at Doctors Hospital.

Funeral services will be held Monday, August 26, 2013, at 11:00 AM from Liberty United Methodist Church, with Reverend Jim Hyder officiating. Mr. Grimaud will lie in state at the church from 10:00 AM until the hour of service. Interment will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Park.

Mr. Grimaud was born in Augusta, Georgia, on June 4th, 1929, to the late Harry Lee and Essie Cornelia Byrd Grimaud. He served in the United States Marine Corps and in the Marine Corps Reserves from 1952 until 1964. He was a charter member of Burns Memorial United Methodist Church.
