Waynesboro, GA - Mr. Lamar Prescott, 85, entered into rest Thursday, September 5, 2013, at University Hospital.

Mr. Prescott, son of the late Wilbur and Lillian Jenkins Prescott, was born in Jenkins County and was a member of Habersham United Methodist Church. He was self-employed as a farmer and was named Farmer of the Year in 1951. He served as President of the Board of Gold Kist for 30 years and was a former board member of the Farm Bureau and of Nutra Sweet. He also served on the Briar Creek Soil Conservation Committee for many years.
