Augusta, GA - Betty Ford, 86, wife of the late William O. "Bill" Ford, entered into rest Saturday, July 26, 2014, at NHC Healthcare, North Augusta.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, July 31, 2014, at 11:00 AM, from Burns Memorial United Methodist Church with Reverend Jerry Peele officiating. She will lie in state one hour prior to the service.

Interment will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Park.
