Augusta, GA - Gurney Flake Pharr, SFC, US Army Retired, 86, beloved husband of the late Rachel Maxine Pharr, entered into rest on Saturday, March 28, 2015 at his residence.

Funeral services will be held from the chapel of Chance & Hydrick Funeral Directors this Thursday, April 2, 2015, at 11:00 AM, with the Reverend Bill Pharr and the Reverend Charlie DeLoach officiating. Interment with full military honors will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Graniteville, SC.
