She loved strawberry sundaes and chocolate covered raisins for her "midnight snacks". At lunch time, she always asked for a Little Debbie "sweet cake". Her love of music accompanied her love for people. Whenever she met someone new, she assigned them a role in her band. Though she never took a lesson, she had a natural talent for every instrument, especially the guitar and the drums. When she played, she'd say "I'm good, ain't I?" She was so much more than good, she was a gift.

Other survivors include her brother, John S. Bugg, Jr. and his wife Susan; and

her sister and brother-in-law, Wanda and Phillip Dyches; as well as her nieces and nephews, Michael Bugg, Ruth Gates, Anthony Byches and Katie Hardesty.
