Augusta, GA - Rev. Marion Keith Jordan, 84, husband of Virginia Moses Jordan for 62 years entered into rest Saturday, March 3, 2018 at Memorial University Medical Center.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at 3:00 P.M., in the chapel of Chance & Hydrick Funeral Directors with Reverend Patrick Latta officiating. Interment will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Park with full-military-honors.
