Brianna was able to bring an abundance of love and sunshine to all the family and friends she touched during her short time. She faced extremely difficult life challenges - ones that no child should have to - but did so with a fierce desire to come through the other side strong. She was a talented artist (despite being too critical of her work) and those of us who managed to wrestle a drawing from her, before she decided it was not good enough, are blessed to have a piece of her in remembrance.

In May 2021, Brianna was diagnosed with epilepsy. This diagnosis made her world small and because she was, at the core, a steadfastly independent young woman, it was difficult for her to accept limitations. Her head and body are no longer hurting and that brings, those who love her, some small comfort.

She believed in a Being who cared for souls once a person's body wore out. As I write this last tribute to her, I know we all pray that her soul is comforted.

Brianna's eyes were lovingly donated to the GA Eye Bank for transplant. May others be so blessed as to see the sunshine and beautiful art in this world, that she no longer can.
