Stone Mountain, GA - Robert Kenneth "Ken" Sanders, 80, beloved husband of 60 years to Mrs. Patricia "Pat" Sanders, entered into rest on Wednesday, March 31, 2021, at his home in Stone Mountain, GA.

A graveside service will be held in Hillcrest Memorial Park, on Monday, April 5, 2021 at 2:00 P.M., with his son, Dr. Robert T Sanders officiating. Family and friends may visit at the funeral home on Monday from 1:00pm until the hour of the service.
