Augusta, GA – Entered into rest, Mr. Charles Eugene Mays, 73, beloved husband of 50 years to Mrs. Sandra “Sandy” Mays, on Saturday, April 12, 2025, at Piedmont Hospital.

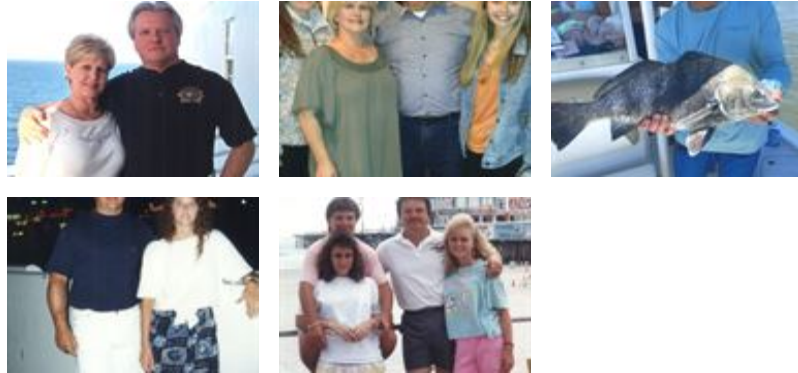
