Claude Albert Faglier, 99, a child of the King, went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Friday, July 28, 2023.

A Service of Celebration will be held Monday morning, July 31, 2023, at 11 o'clock from the Chapel of Chance and Hydrick Funeral Directors with Rev. Steve Hartman, Rev. Larry Harmon, and Rev. 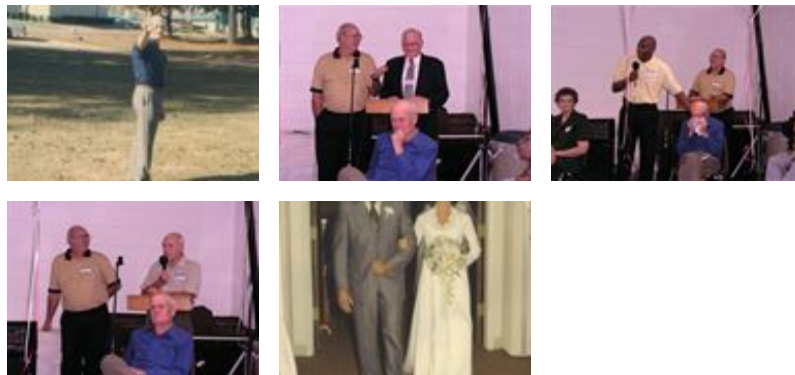
