Pickens, SC - David Jerome Morse was born in Louisiana on May 18, 1953, and passed away on February 22, 2025, in Pickens, South Carolina at the age of 71.

A service to celebrate his life will be held at Chance and Hydrick Funeral Directors on June 7, 2025, at 1:00 P.M., with the Reverend Dr. Timothy Pendrey officiating. Mr. Morse will be interred in Hillcrest Memorial Park. He was the oldest of his brothers and sisters whom he loved dearly (along with his parents and a large extended family) and his entire family loved him too. He had married and divorced during his lifetime but did not have any children.

David joined the U.S. Army in New Orleans, Louisiana and served his country faithfully for many years – overseas and at home. He was in the Military Police for almost 5 of those years and received an achievement medal and a good conduct medal during his military service. David had achieved the rank of Sergeant when he left the army with an honorable discharge and returned to Louisiana. David loved exploring the great outdoors and camped all over the northwest until he finally settled in Kansas.

Eventually, he moved to Pickens South Carolina to be closer to his family where they lived in both South Carolina and Georgia. David was kind and gentle with others – although David did like his solitude and was set in his

ways. He was not judgmental of anyone and was generous to a fault with his family and others. He was very vocal about his politics and loved to have spirited political discussions with the family. David was very intelligent and a deep thinker. He was an avid reader and owned hundreds of books which he cherished. David became a devout man who studied the bible for the rest of his life and surely, he died in God's good grace.
