She was an avid reader, enjoyed working in her yard, and was an exceptional cook-her daughter fondly remembers that there was nothing she couldn't make. Preparing meals for her family brought her joy, and if you ever left her table hungry, it was your own fault.

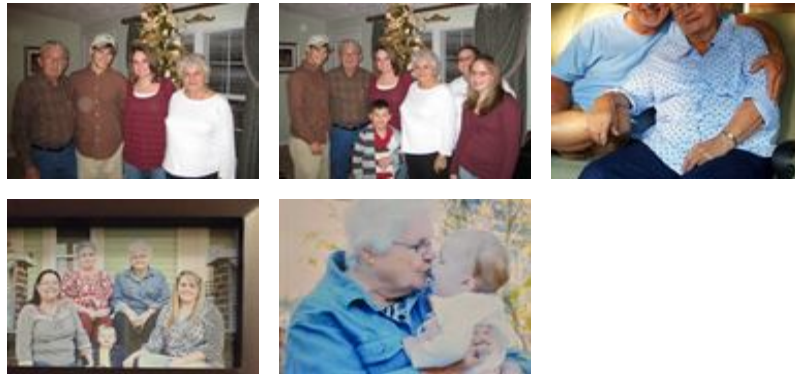
