Hephzibah, GA – Jay Douglas Rimmer, 72, beloved husband of Laurie Price Rimmer, entered into rest on Saturday, March 1, 2025, at his residence after a brief battle with liver cancer.

A funeral service will be held from the chapel of Chance and Hydrick Funeral Directors on Thursday, March 6, 2025 at 2:00 P.M. with Father Vincent Vodjogbe, of Holy Trinity Catholic Church, officiating. 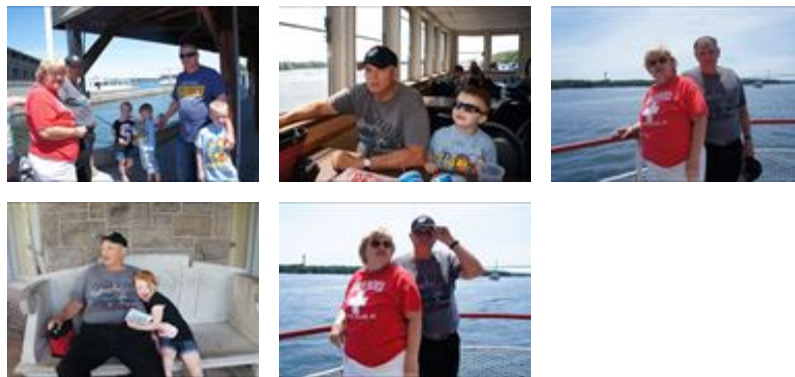
