Margaret J. Robertson, 84, went to be with her Lord and Savior Friday, January 24, 2025. She was laid to rest in a private service January 28th. In honor of her final wishes, a memorial service to celebrate her life will be held Saturday, February 22, 2025, 4 pm, at Trinity on the Hill.

Margaret was preceded in death by her loving husband of 34 years, A. E. Robertson, Jr. She is survived by her son, Curtis Robertson (Jackie); daughter, Denise Robertson; Cousin Letty Wiederkehr (Jim); daughter, Debbie Arcuri as well as grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

A native of Augusta, GA, Margaret graduated from Academy of Richmond County and later Augusta Technical College. Her career covered a period in retail before accepting a position at Augusta Christian Schools daycare in 1976. She was soon promoted to Director and served there for 12 years. After graduation from Augusta Tech, she became an assistant for a local attorney's office. Her final position as secretary was within her church home where she also taught Sunday School, sang in the choir, lead Bible study and volunteered for many activities until her health prevented her from doing so.

For more than 16 years, her health declined and eventually her memory as well. The one constant in her life was her relationship with God, her Father. She knew she was a child of the King and her purpose on this earth was to be
