Mr. Justice, a native and lifelong resident of the Augusta area, was the son of the late Jesse "Pete" and Nellie Justice. Mr. Justice attended Butler High School (class of 1972).

Steve married his high school sweetheart Susan, and they spent nearly 49 years together.

Steve was very involved with Little League and Cal Ripken Baseball for more than 45 years. He served many years in multiple capacities at Masters City Little League, including serving as President for many years. He was instrumental in bringing Cal Ripken Baseball to Hephzibah and actually helped build the fields and the concession stand. He coached countless children and promoted the love of baseball.

Steve enjoyed hunting, fishing and scuba diving in his younger years. Steve loved dogs and enjoyed riding his beloved Zeekie and Bella around on his golf

cart.

Steve loved his family and friends. He smiled bravely, faced his illness, and always said, "I don't feel better but I don't feel worse."
